

## FAB Covid Policy 2022

FAB 2022 is designed with health and safety of all participants in mind. All attendees, speakers, staff, and volunteers will be required to present *either* proof of full vaccination status or a negative COVID test from the past 48 hours before attending June 5-7. In general, people are considered fully vaccinated: 2 weeks after their second dose in a 2-dose series, such as the Pfizer or Moderna vaccines, or 2 weeks after a single-dose vaccine, such as Johnson & Johnson's Janssen vaccine. In addition, booster shots are highly encouraged, but not mandatory. Event staff will verify this information on-site via card or photocopy of card.

Should there be any changes with another wave or new variant, FAB will comply with the latest guidelines set by the CDC, the State of South Carolina, and the City of Charleston. Masks may be required for all attendees, regardless of vaccination status, while indoors.

FAB will provide access to hand sanitizer and disposable masks.

We ask individuals to NOT attend the event if any of the following conditions are true for you:

- *Within 7 days before attending FAB you have tested positive, or been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19;*
- *Within 48 hours prior to attending FAB, you have experienced symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g. a fever of 100.4F or higher, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shivering, muscle pain / aches, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, nasal congestion, runny nose, vomiting or diarrhea, fatigue, or any other symptoms associated with COVID-19 identified by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention);*
- *Within 14 days prior to attending FAB, you have traveled to any international territory identified by federal or applicable state or local governments as being subject to travel or quarantine advisories due to COVID-19.*
- *In an effort to keep all safe, we would encourage you to home test before arriving at FAB to be on the safe side!*
